

Accessing the path to Llyn Geirionydd!



1. Turn left out of our drive and walk through the village past the small parade of shops on the right
2. After the woollen mill and old school building on the right hand side take the next right turn up the very steep hill
3. Follow the road round to the left and after the house with the large penguin on the green door (!) turn left onto Jubilee Road



4. Carry on up Jubilee Road a short distance and as the road turns to the left *instead* continue straight ahead on a footpath next to a (faded) yellow grit bin

5. At the top of the path where the steps end turn right onto another road



6. Soon after you - on the left hand side - you will see a public footpath sign and a wooden post with a 'Trefriw Trail' marker on it - this is the start of the path!

7. The path runs all the way to Llyn Geirionydd. Once you reach the lake at point B you can either retrace your steps, or walk around it clockwise (along the road first) or anti-clockwise (turn right at B and follow the shore-line)
