

Moel Siabod

1. Park at “Bryn Glo” (on Google Maps) - if full carry on to the “Tyn-y-Coed Hotel” where you can park for approx. £10 (pay in the hotel)
2. Follow the instructions in the book, crossing the old stone arched bridge and taking the lane then path towards the farm and holiday cottages
3. The main track towards the summit is obvious now:



4. You will skirt a small lake on the left hand side, then head past old quarry workings and a flooded quarry pit, before skirting Llyn y Foel lake (below) on the left of you heading towards a ridge (the path can be indistinct here)



5. Approach the ridge on the left side, and you can either scramble on the ridge itself (challenging but fun!), or on the left side of it there is a faint path of sorts which goes most of the way to the summit area

6. Once at the summit / trig point to descend head for the distinctive ridge in the distance and veer left of it to find the obvious path down



7. Once near the bottom you can head for “Moel Siabod cafe” on the main road (try the scones!) before heading back along the road back to the car park, or you can head back into the woods and take the forest track back
