

## Snowdon in your pocket!

## Llanberis path

The path up Snowdon from Llanberis is the longest by distance although it has a generally less steep gradient than other routes.

Start behind the Mountain Railway station and walk towards the Royal Victoria Hotel, then turn right up Victoria Terrace when you reach the mini roundabout. Ahead, pass the row of terraced houses and aim for the minor road heading over the cattle grid and uphill.

Keep on the minor road through a gate and past some modern barns.

Very soon after, there's a footpath marker stone to your left pointing to the Snowdon Summit.

The path roughly follows the Mountain Railway - prebooking is essential: return and one-way tickets *up* are available. One-way tickets *down* are only available on a standby basis. See <u>www.snowdonrailway.co.uk</u> for more information. For added variety, you can take the PYG or Miners tracks back down the mountain to Pen-y-Pass and then catch the <u>Sherpa bus</u> back to Llanberis.

To reach Llanberis from Crafnant House:

- turn left out of our drive and take the B5106 to **Betws-y-Coed** 

- in Betws, turn right onto the A5 towards Bangor

- at **Capel Curig** turn left onto the A4086 towards Llanberis

- follow signs for **Llanberis**, turning right at the Pen-y-Gwryd hotel. You will pass Pen-y-Pass car park at the crest of the hill before the road heads down to Nant Peris and then Llanberis

There are several large car parks in Llanberis - please avoid parking on residential streets.
