



## Walking to the Grey Mare's Tail Waterfall / Betws-y-Coed

Turn left out of our drive and walk through the village past the small parade of shops on the right

After the woollen mill and old school building on the right hand side take the next right up the (very!) steep hill



Follow the round round to the left and after the house with the large penguin on the green garage door (!) turn left onto Jubilee Road



Carry on up Jubilee Road a short distance and continue straight ahead on a footpath next to the (faded!) yellow grit bin

At the top of the path where the steps end turn left onto another road



Continue up this road, and after the road bends to the right head for a track / gate leading off to the left. (DON'T go up the steep "single track road"!)

Carry on along this track through woods for a short while as it heads downhill, and eventually it leads you to a stile / gate and the main road.



Walk along the road for a short distance on the right hand side, taking care due to oncoming traffic coming around the bend. Another track soon rises up opposite the rugby club gates. Continue on this track up the hill, after which it levels out and eventually leads to a road leading to a gate / house. Continue along the road.



This same road leads to the Grey Mare's Tail waterfall (you will hear it!) - a gate on the left hand side leads to the path which heads down to the waterfall. You can either continue through the gorge to head to Llanrwst, or retrace your steps back up to the road which soon leads to Sawbench car park, from which the main track to Betws-y-Coed starts.
